Welcome Back Mathematician!

Welcome to seventh grade Math! I am very excited to have all of you in class. I am sure this year will prove to be a successful one. Here are a few important details about my class that will ensure your success.

Class Rules:

1. Treat everyone with respect.
2. Be prepared – come to class with a pencil, bring your Math folder, and have your homework with you and done!
3. Raise your hand before speaking.
4. You must attempt every question and SHOW WORK! No Work, No Credit!

Supply List:

- Three-ring binder (binder will stay in Math classroom)
- Dividers with tabs (for binder)
- Math Folder (folder will bring homework and notes home)
- Agenda
- Pencil
- Whiteboard marker, glue stick, highlighter, small scissors (extras in classroom)

Grading Policy:

- Tests 40% (8 unit tests, 3 trimester tests)
- Quizzes 35% (section quizzes, some classroom activities)
- Classwork 15% (warm-ups, activities, presentations, exit tickets)
- Homework 10%

Homework Policy:

Students should expect homework every night. They must show work for full credit. Students may pass in homework the next day for half credit. Students who are absent for more than one day are given the number of days they were out plus one to pass in all missed assignments. Absent work is available in the “While you were out” folder in the back of the room.

Completing homework is an important part of a students’ success in Math!

Test Corrections:

Any student who wishes to bring up their test grade can schedule a time to meet with me to go over the test and correct their mistakes. Students cannot bring the test home to complete test corrections, all corrections must be done at school either during team time or after school. Students will receive half of the points back if corrections are completed correctly.

Extra Credit:

- Challenge of the Week- Correct answers with work are worth 1-3 points on a test. They are available on Monday, due on Monday of the next week. You can collect and pass in the challenge of the week to the blue bin at the front of the room.
- Tickets- Additional extra points can be received from tickets earned in class. Tickets can be earned from a variety of things, anything from helping a fellow student who dropped their books to winning a math challenge activity in class. 5 tickets = 1 homework pass OR 2 points on a test (your choice).
